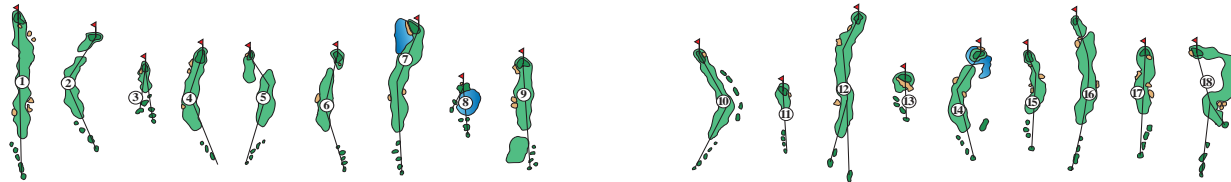

USGA Rules Govern All Play

Out of Bounds: Defined by Boundary Fences or White Stakes.

Lateral Hazards: Defined by Red Stakes or Lines.

Water Hazards: Defined by Yellow Stakes or Lines. If tee shot on hole #8 enters water hazard, ball may be dropped in designated drop area or proceed under water hazard rule. Penalty one stroke.

Local Rule Exceptions:

Carts on cart path only: Holes #4, #9 and #16 and all Par 3's.

Drains filled with drain rock: Relief given if stance or swing interfered with, no nearer hole.

Staked Trees: Relief from tree, stake, and wires granted when normal stance or swing might injure tree, but not line of sight relief.

Rockscape: Free drop, no nearer hole, through the green. Exception: Bunker Hole #13 and other hazards.

Do not use public streets except at designated crossings. Be sure traffic light is in your favor!

Kirby yardage markers are provided on cart paths as well as on fairways. When carts are restricted to paths only, please observe yardages on path to center of green and take several clubs with you to speed up play.

Please observe all Cart Rules & Signage.

- Water fountains at restrooms at #4, #9, #14.
- Invite faster groups to play through.
- Each player must have a set of clubs.
- Dress code required as posted.
